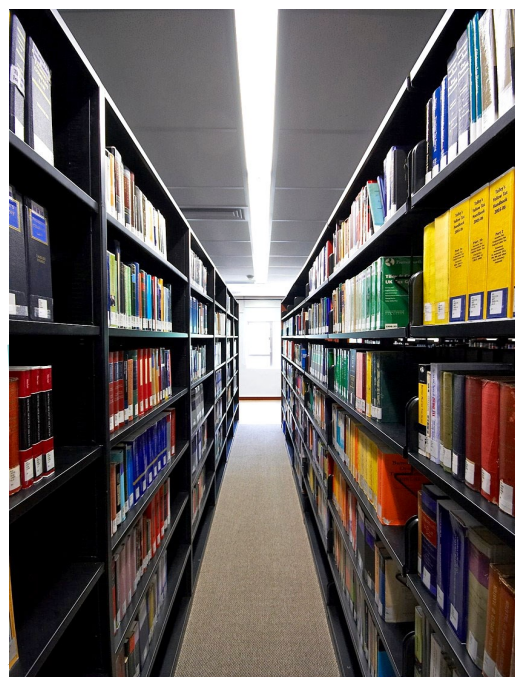

The CUHK Library has recently launched the new library website: <http://lib.cuhk.edu.hk/en>

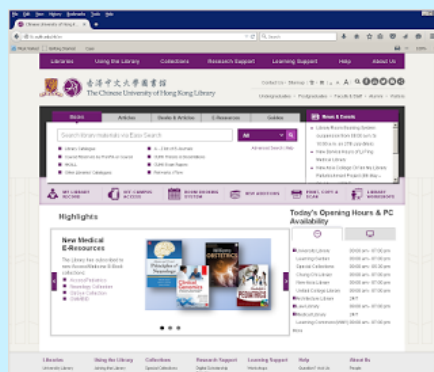
New features include:

How to Find ebooks

There are two ways to search for ebooks: 1). Go to CUHK Library Catalogue, 2). Go to individual ebook platforms.

1). CUHK Library Catalogue

Go to the Library Catalogue (<http://lib.cuhk.edu.hk/>) to enter search terms in the open box and select eBooks to search individual ebook title(s) of a particular topic. You can access the ebook directly from the library record under the **View Online** tab. It also provides the licence agreements in the library record.

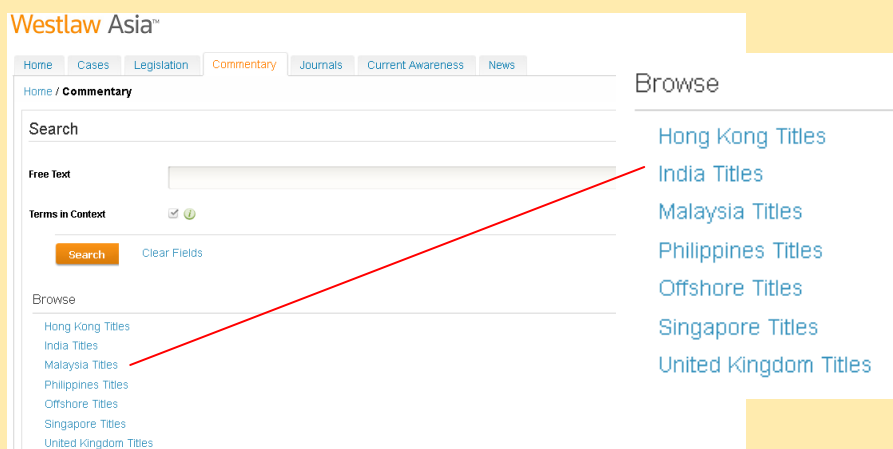

A New Platform of Westlaw – Westlaw Asia is launched!

Westlaw is one of the major legal databases the Law Library subscribes to. Westlaw has launched a new interface called Westlaw Asia. It is a single platform for searching Asian legal materials across multiple countries within a single search. It is an ideal tool for comparative law research, and a significant time saver.

The Westlaw HK and Westlaw Asia will run parallel for a while until every resource has been migrated to Westlaw Asia. Currently, some titles are only available in either Westlaw HK or Westlaw Asia: *Professional Conduct & Risk Management in Hong Kong* is only available in Westlaw HK whereas (selected) *Annotated Legislation* and *Asia Business Guide* (excepted Hong Kong Commentary) are only found in Westlaw Asia.

Westlaw Asia include some popular HK and UK book titles, for example, HK titles: *Law of Companies in Hong Kong*, *Company Law in Hong Kong*, *Tort Law & Practice in Hong Kong*, and *Hong Kong Civil Procedure* (Hong Kong White Book); UK titles: *Benjamin's Sales of Goods*, *Chitty on Contracts*, *Dicey, Morris & Collins The Conflict of Laws*, and *Phipson on Evidence*.
